Having been members of the International Academy of Oral Medicine and Toxicology for almost 20 years, we understood the need to remove mercury from our wastewater and installed a separator many years before NYS mandated them. After we met the owner of MARS at our academy's semi-annual conferences, we invested in their product for the many reasons noted below.

Since we switched our office over to the M.A.R.S. LibertyBOSS, we have noticed a significant savings on our amalgam separator costs, as well as an improvement in our suction.

We are extremely happy with our LibertyBOSS amalgam separator; it is a relief to not have to constantly maintain our old SolmeteX unit anymore. Compared to our old unit, the LibertyBOSS requires no maintenance at all and we are reminded when it is coming due for replacing plus we receive a Certificate of Compliance with this information. Our unit only needs to be changed every 24 months now making compliance much easier.

As is noted in the recommendations in the NYS mandate, only certain evacuation products should be used to allow proper sedimentation thereby decreasing the mercury discharge even further. The M.A.R.S. LINZ 3 Pack contains an effective evacuation line system and we have been using it with good results. The quarterly cleaner, CleanLINZ, works so well. We don't have to clean out our traps as often, as well as they are not as disgusting as they use to be. PowerLINZ is an excellent disinfectant for our evacuation lines. We feel these products are more economical than we had expected.

I would recommend the MARS amalgam separator and the suction line products to make this system one of the most efficient for the removal of mercury from our waste water stream.
